ISWE welcomes carefully prepared abstracts reporting new basic, applied, or methodological-related research findings concerning wildlife endocrinology, with emphasis on non-invasive and minimally invasive sampling technologies used to address questions applied to adrenal function, reproductive physiology, animal health, welfare, ecology, and evolution.

Topic categories include reproductive function, integrative animal health, long-term studies of wildlife, biomarkers of physiologic stress, new techniques for applied endocrinology, and miscellaneous.

All authors of approved abstracts will be asked to prepare and submit a recorded, oral, five-minute slide presentation, which will be available for viewing by all Virtual Event attendees for up to two weeks after Event dates.
